PROPER HOUSE FOR POULTRY

Mistaken Idea to Think That Hens Do Not Lay in Winter Because Their Coop is Not Warm.

Very often I hear persons say, "Our hens don't lay in the winter because our hen house is not warm enough."

I don't wish to have it understood that my houses are open with cracks and knot holes, for they are not; every part is made tight except at the windows where the muslin curtain is in.

EXCELLENT FEED FOR HENS

Turnips Nailed to Board With Cut Side Up Affords Fowl Green Truck Needed in Winter.

Turnips make an excellent green food for laying hens during winter. The best way to feed them is to cut

them in halves, nail them on a board with cut side up, and place where the hens can have free access. Turnips take the place of grass and other greens which cannot be had in winter. The object in cutting and feeding in this way is to prevent the hens from scratching them through dirt and litter. Potatoes and apples can also be fed in the same manner.

New Poultry Roost. A new poultry roost is made of perforated iron tubing which has been treated with a solution deadly to insect life.

The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad has enlisted in the nation-wide crusade for the extermination of tuberculosis, having fitted up an anti-tuberculosis exhibit car at the Mount Clear shops for the Maryland Association for the Prevention and Relief of Tuberculosis, which will visit the towns of Maryland in an educational campaign looking to the eradication of the white plague. The car is designed to display anti-tuberculosis exhibits and lectures will be delivered on the prevention of the disease by local physicians at the cities and towns to be visited in the State.

CONGRESS WILL DISCUSS HEALTH AND SANITATION.

International Gatherings in Washington in September—Authorized by President Taft—Countries to be Represented—Immense exhibit to be Shown.

Washington, February 1st. Washington will become the Mecca for sanitarians from all parts of the world when the 15th International Congress on Hygiene and Demography meets here in September.

Among the states which have not signified their official intention of being present are New York, Massachusetts, Pennsylvania, and Ohio.

For the first time in its history of fifty years, the Congress will be held on American soil. Arrangements for the preliminary work have been made under the direct authorization of President Taft, whose Honorary President of the Congress, and with the active co-operation of the State Department.

While the dates of the Congress itself are from September 23rd to 28th, the exhibition will open early in September and will continue until after the Congress.


