FROM HERE, THERE AND EVERYWHERE.

During June the public baths of Baltimore city were used by 104,422 persons—93,554 men and boys, 30,813 women and girls.

Sweeping reductions in express rates averaging, in general, approximately 15 per cent.; drastic reforms in regulations and practices, and comprehensive changes in the methods of operation, are prescribed in a report made public by the Interstate Commerce Commission of its investigation into the business of the thirteen great express companies of the United States.

In Vincennes, a suburb of Paris, are four blocks of workmen's flats. The birth of a baby in any one of these flats frees the tenant from the payment of the following quarter's rent. This is being done, of course, to encourage large families among the workmen, to whom the problem of housing a large family is a serious one in Paris. These workmen's flats have baths, wash houses, a library and a dispensary for the care of newborn infants.

Fifteen persons were killed and fifteen to twenty were injured in a wreck on the Chicago Burlington and Quincy Railroad at Western Springs, a suburb of Chicago, at 6.30 a. m., Sunday. Coming through a fog, with supposedly a clear track ahead, train No. 8, a fast mail, ran at full speed into the rear of train No. 2, known as Overland Express, from Denver, which was standing still on the track, telescoping two of the Overland's Pullman cars.

Fort McHenry, the birthplace of the "Star-Spangled Banner," is no longer a military fort. Until a year ago three companies were always kept at the fort, each of about 100 men. Now the one remaining company, 14th Coast Artillery, is to be removed and the old fort patrolled by a small number of men from Fort Howard, who will keep it in order and distribute the food and supplies brought there for Fort Howard and other forts on the river.

Leaving behind a note "To All Concerned," saying they intended to hereafter lead better lives, five prisoners of the Frederick county jail early Sunday morning crawled through an opened window, made by sawing an iron bar, on the second floor, and dropped to the ground in the jail yard. The jail yard is surrounded by a brick wall 30 feet high. Two prisoners managed to get over the wall, and the two over were in the act of drawing the others over the wall when a shot from the revolver of Sheriff Fagan cut short the proceedings. The result was three prisoners were left in the jail yard and easily captured, while two made good their escape.
