A trial trip was given one of his trains a few days ago, and it was pronounced a success. Of course, with this type of car and battery, it is not necessary to have poles or wires. The batteries can be recharged at the power houses.

In connection with this type of railway car, it might be well to mention the difficulties that are now being experienced by all of our citizens who use our only railroad for passenger service between Baltimore and Reisterstown.

GOVERNOR ON ROADS.

Tells of Progress on State Work During His Administration.

We have received a copy of the statement made by Governor Goldsborough on October 3, 1912 as to State Roads. The part of it relating to Carroll county is as follows: "The 2.60 miles from Sykesville to Eldersburg have been completed and are in good condition. About 3 miles of the 4.67 miles from Eldersburg to Gamber have been completed, and the section of 5.30 miles from Gamber to Fenby will soon be finished. When this work is done, it will give a continuous State road of 16.07 miles from Sykesville north to Westminster. Arrangements have been concluded for the transfer to the State of the 1.50 miles from Fenby to Westminster."


