

Waynesboro Foundry Company Installs Two New Machines.

The following clipping concerning the Waynesboro Metal and Foundry Company, which is a branch of the Westminister Company, is taken from the "Waynesboro (Pa.) Herald":

"The Waynesboro Metal and Foundry Company has received two new machines for the refining of brass, to be installed in its plant in South Waynesboro.

One of the new machines is a grinding machine, weighing five tons. This machine is used to work up brass to be refined. It has a capacity of two carloads a week. The machine will be placed on a substantial concrete base which is under construction.

The other machine is a concentrator. This machine is used for separating the fine brass from the brass ashes and has a capacity equal to that of the grinding machine.

Electric motors are being installed to operate the new machinery. The Waynesboro Electric Light & Power Company is running wires from South Church street to the foundry to provide current.

E. D. Scott is superintending the installation of the added equipment."




