The board of School Commissioners of Carroll County held a regular meeting on Monday, November 1, beginning at 10 a. m., all the members being present.  
 After the reading and approval of the minutes of the last meeting the regular order of business was taken up.  
 The matter of putting a fence around the lot at Tracey's school was left in charge of J. W. Hoffacker, and certain other repairs at Pleasant Gap in charge of A. N. Zentz.  
 The patrons of Fritzelburg school having raised \$25 toward digging a well on the school premises, the board agreed to contribute an amount sufficient to complete the work. It was decided not to make any more contributions for this purpose within the present school year.

### Election Results in Other States.

New York.—Suffrage and new Constitution defeated by overwhelming majorities. Three Republican Congressmen elected. Republican Assembly elected, though with slight losses. Entire Tammany ticket elected in New York county.  
 Pennsylvania.—Suffrage defeated. One Republican Congressman elected. Thomas B. Smith (Rep.) elected Mayor of Philadelphia by 75,000.  
 Massachusetts.—Suffrage defeated. Samuel W. McCall (Rep.) elected Governor over David I. Walsh by close vote. Republican Legislature returned with decided gains.  
 Kentucky.—Former Congressman A. O. Stanley (Dem.) elected Governor by about 10,000.  
 Ohio.—Prohibition defeated.  
 New Jersey.—Republicans gained two State Senators in the election of members of the Legislature. Entire new Assembly of 40 Republicans and 20 Democrats elected. Of six Senators elected, three are Republicans and three are Democrats, succeeding five Democrats and one Republican.  
 Mississippi.—Full Democratic ticket, headed by Theo. G. Bilbo as Governor, elected.  
 Virginia.—Democratic Assembly elected. "Drys" will have heavy majority for enactment of prohibition amendment effective November 1, 1916.
