Tuskegee Official Thinks 100,000 Negroes Are Eager To Enlist.

Victor H. Tulane and other Montgomery (Ala.) negroes have opened an enlistment place for negro volunteers. Upon receiving news that members of the Tenth United States Cavalry (negro) had been killed Montgomery negroes were eager for an opportunity to enlist, and a full regiment will be offered for service the day the United States call for volunteers.

Edmett J. Scott, secretary of Tuskegee Institute, says that former Tuskegee graduates will make up a regiment, and that if the Government will accept them he believes 100,000 sturdy negroes will enlist.—From the Birmingham Age-Herald.




