

**Fell Into Niagara Gorge.**

Niagara Falls, N. Y., May 14.—Although they fell 160 feet into the Niagara Gorge this afternoon, Theodor Meroczek, aged 45, and his eight-year-old daughter, were still alive tonight in a local hospital.

They were walking on the brow of the cliff when the girl slipped. The father tried to save her, but both went over the brink and fell to the jagged rocks below. They will probably die, physicians said.

At the hospital late tonight the girl told detectives that her father threw her over the bank and then jumped after her. Meroczek, when questioned, changed his story and said that two men threw the girl over and then threw him after her.

Friends of the Meroczek's said that the father had been worrying over money troubles and the recent death of his wife.
