Mt. Airy To Float Bonds.

Plans are being made by the authorities of Mt. Airy to float a bond issue of \$22,000 provided by the last Legislature and ratified by the voters of the town for a new water system. The bonds will draw interest at the rate of 5 per cent and will be serial, \$1,000 worth to be taken up annually. The bonds will be exempt from municipal and county taxation and it is thought that the larger portion, perhaps the entire issue, will be subscribed by residents of the town and community.

Some time ago a bond issue of \$18,000 was floated for street improvement. The main thoroughfare was concreted and enough remained to start the new water system. It is thought that the coming issue of \$22,000 will complete the water system and provide for further street improvement. A survey has been made for the latter improvement, which will be half a mile of hard road.



Work on the \$1,000,000 coal pier of the Western Maryland Railroad, which is being constructed at Port Covington, has progressed to the driving of the 85 foot piles which will support the steel superstructure. Divers are also at work placing the stay lathing on which will rest the concrete base of the approach. Operations were commenced on April 1 and it is expected that the pier will be completed about October 1.
