

**A SPLENDID EXHIBIT.**

Dealers and Promoters Complimented  
On the Successful Auto Show.

The automobile show held in the Armory last week was a decided success in every way.

The spirit of cooperation between the dealers and the committee directing the show, was splendid. The dealers all expressed themselves to the effect that they considered the show successful from every angle and destined to be an annual affair. The committee and members of Carroll Post No. 21, The American Legion, feels that it was successful both from the dealers and the public's standpoint, as well as their own. The people attending the show were enthusiastic, many of them surprised. They were very profuse in their commendation.

Thursday, October 28, the opening day, found everything set. At least 500 attended. On Friday the crowd numbered about 750 persons. Saturday was the big day about 1200 tickets being collected at the entrance.

The main floor of the Armory was divided off into twelve spaces, six on either side of a main aisleway. The stage was divided so as to accommodate four booths.




