

The object of this suit is to procure a divorce a vinculo matrimonii by Marie Stumpf from Joseph Stumpf; the bill states that the parties were married April 1914, in Baltimore, Md., by Father Tyson, of St. Michael's Catholic Church; that after said marriage the parties resided in Baltimore City until 1915, then removed to Pittsburgh, Pa., where plaintiff remained with defendant nine months and again plaintiff returned to Baltimore, Md., early in 1914, with the six children born to parties to cause; that defendant in Baltimore and in Pittsburgh abandoned and abused plaintiff and their children and drove plaintiff from his home in Pittsburgh; that five children yet live; that the conduct of plaintiff toward defendant has always been chaste and above reproach and that defendant has abused, beat, neglected, abandoned plaintiff and their children and drove them from his home and has not contributed to support of plaintiff or children since January, 1914; that plaintiff resided in Baltimore, Md., from January, 1914, to September, 1919, and has resided in Carroll County, Md., from September, 1919, to date of filing this bill; that defendant is a non-resident of the State of Maryland; that bill prays a divorce a vinculo matrimonii, award of guardianship of children and other relief.


