Dynamite Kills Four Men

Trenton, March 16.—Benjamin Hardesty, of Hampton, lost his inquisitive cow when she got on the business end of a stick of dynamite, but the House of Assembly tried to do the right thing by Mr. Hardesty today by passing the bill to permit the State to pay him \$125 as cow insurance.

Some weeks ago the Department of Highways was fixing up the roads around Hampton a bit and it was necessary to do some blasting. A stick of dynamite lay on the ground and the heifer munched it. In a little while it was certain for the cow and Hardesty thought the State ought to reimburse him, as she was a perfectly good cow.

Has Mine Cave-in

Scranton, Pa., March 18.—Fifteen persons were compelled to flee for their lives when a mine cave-in in the heart of the city today wrecked a garage and a dwelling at Mulberry street and Wyoming avenue and dropped part of the structure 40 feet into the mine.

Later the front of the two-story brick building crumbled and fell to pieces and the floor of the garage caved in, dropping automobiles into the workings.
