COGNAC GETS NASH IN BAD.

E. T. Nash, Sykesville, who is said to have stirred the enthusiasm of his fellow-townsmen when he placed on sale many eight-ounce bottles of what he elected to name Cognac and brandy extract, was held under \$1000 bail for the action of the Federal Grand Jury by Commissioner Supple Monday.

One of the accusations against Nash is that he sold to minors, and complaints were made at prohibition headquarters by some of the constables. The man maintained that he was not responsible if purchasers used the extract as a beverage. In 10 days, recently, he admitted, he sold five dozen bottles in Sykesville. He denied that he told prohibition agents his sales went as high as 135 bottles daily.

Harry B. Kellogg, a police sergeant of Chicago, who was sentenced 15 days in jail shot at the judge and fatally wounded the prosecuting attorney. He also shot himself, but not fatally.


