
SLEDDERS INJURED

\$25,000,000 to Be Given States For Good Roads

Washington, Jan. 16.—The House good roads committee reported a bill appropriating \$25,000,000 government funds for assistance to the States in the construction of good roads. Apportionment to the States is to be made on a basis of population, acreage and rural mileage. Each State is appropriate for roads annually an amount equal to that allotted to it by the government.
