OVERSOLD CONDITION IN ACTIVE STOCKS

Rock Island and Mercantile Marine Issues Made Better Showing Today
New York, Feb. 11. - An oversold condition in many of the active stocks was apparent to-day when prices rose materially notwithstanding the small amount of buying.
