The guests were summoned to the big dining room by the gong--relaying of an ancient auctioneer-bell, which had been sequestered for the occasion. The room was hung with theatrical posters by way of decoration, Jack Johnson and the Volunteer Organist being placed along side some thrillers from the fronts of the "movies." The guests had taken their seats on the balcony. In a second moment later a big muzzle in red electric lights flashed on the wall over the president's chair and was followed by a big sword showing in red and green on the face of the balcony.
