

Big Grain Warehouse at Leesburg Struck by Lightning

Special to The Telegraph. Carlisle, Pa., June 25.—During last night's heavy electrical storm light-

ning struck the large grain warehouse at Leesburg, a town of 300 inhabitants about four miles from Shippensburg, and the resulting fire completely destroyed the large building. The Leesburg station of the Philadelphia, Harrisburg and Pittsburgh railroad was located in one end of the burned building. A bucket brigade saved the

houses of the town, as there was great danger at times of a general spread of the flames. The warehouse was owned by H. J. Brinkerhoff, ex-member of the Legislature from the county. The loss is estimated at from \$15,000 to \$18,000, about \$10,000 representing the loss on grain.
