Movement in Specities Continued With Gains in Some Issues; Bond List Quiet

New York, July 7. — The morning session wrought no pronounced changes in the representative group, few of which varied more than fractions. The movement in the specialties continued, however, with further gains in issues already mentioned, as well as in Dry Goods, Pfd., which rose almost four points. Rock Island, Pfd., and the coal trust joined the common shares in establishing new low records. Sudden activity in Missouri Pacific 4 per cent. bonds and the stock which declined five and 1/2 points, respectively, was referable to the proposed financial reorganization of that property. The bond list was quiet except for some strength in Kansas and Texas trusts and International Pump five.

ACTION OF WATER COMPANY SUSTAINED

Camp Hill Loses Its Fight in Opinion Handed Down by Judge Sadler

Decision in Rate Question Will Be Given by Judge Seibert This Week

Carlisle, Pa., July 7.—In an opinion handed down by President Judge W. F. Sadler, of the Cumberland county court, on June 26 and made public to-day, the Riverton Consolidated Water company was affirmed in its action in digging up the streets of Camp Hill for the purpose of turning off the water supply to residents who refused to pay the company an increased rate.

The opinion continues and makes permanent the temporary injunction granted March 27, 1914, restraining officials of the borough of Camp Hill from granting permits to the water company for the purpose of making excavations so that the water supply of consumers who refused to pay their water rent could be disconnected. In the court's ruling several Supreme Court decisions bearing on the question are cited.

The opinion to-day made public does not bear on the rate question over which the controversy between the water company and residents arose. It simply fixes the legality of the company's action in digging up the borough's streets when the borough officials refused to grant permits to employees of the company, instructed to shut off the supply of water at a number of residences where occupants refused to pay a rate which they said was unlawful and not according to the contract drawn up between the water company and the borough officials several years ago. The hearing on the rate question was held here before Judge W. S. Seibert, of the Perry county bench, and an opinion from him is expected this week.

George Fred Williams Resigns So He Can Talk
Washington, D. C., July 7.—The expected resignation of George Fred Williams, of Massachusetts, from the office of Minister to Greece and Montenegro was received by Secretary Bryan by cable.

The resignation was asked for on Friday by President Wilson on account of Mr. Williams' indiscreet utterances concerning the political situation in Albania, but in his cable communication to secretary Bryan, Mr. Williams overlooks that fact and with an apparent lack of consciousness of honor gives as the reason for his retirement that he feels obliged to talk about the Albanian situation and realizes that he cannot do so while he remains in the American diplomatic service.
