The Day of Rest and Human Efficiency

Great organizations have come to realize that the human side must enter largely into their calculations. Efficiency, the length of the working day, the pauses for rest for persons of different ages and stations in life, how to prevent depletion, and how to restore nervous tone. For a long time we have given a weekly half-holiday with pay; taken together this is about fifty-two half-holidays, making twenty-six full days or three and one-half weeks a year with pay. This aside from the fifty-two hours given each year by opening at 9 o'clock Saturday morning.

Our reason for this is that a half-holiday each week gives a regular breathing time in the fresh air that cannot help but be of great benefit to good health.

This is done only with the idea of increasing efficiency and not in a way that would savor of patronage, benevolence or philanthropy with our employes.

We want them to earn each dollar they get and pay them each dollar they earn. Our Profit-sharing Plan aims to do this. Several stores in the city have tried to have the summer half-holiday changed from Friday afternoon to Saturday afternoon and evening. We heartily endorse this movement and believe with the concerted action of every organization in the city it can be brought about.
