

Dogs Should Be Killed Off by Constable Now It's the Apple Leaf Hopper Plague

There is no excuse for dogs being allowed to run at large and kill or maim sheep or other animals in the country any more than there is any reason for them being permitted to go unregistered in a city, according to state officials. In the last few weeks inquiries by the dozens have been received at the Department of Agriculture, Department of Forestry, Game Commission, and other offices complaining that dogs are allowed to run wild in the country and that while some have been found to have rabies others are just dogs which have escaped from their owners and are wild to all intents and purposes. Under the law it is the duty of constables to kill wild dogs or those which are allowed to run at large without registration. The act of Assembly, say officials, places this duty on local officers and the number of dogs giving trouble to farmers can be materially reduced if they will get the local officers to act.
