DIXON DISCOVERS NEW DISINFECTANT

Necessity of Replacing German Product Causes Him to Make Scientific Researches

The big European war inevitably involved the lessening of many importations from abroad upon which the people of Pennsylvania depended.

The State Health Department immediately upon the declaration of war reviewed its stock of foreign chemicals and was reminded that potassium permanganate used in disinfecting rooms after scarlet fever, diphtheria and smallpox, etc., was all made in Germany.

To try and meet this rather alarming situation Commissioner of Health Dr. Samuel G. Dixon, requested the chief chemist, Dr. C. H. LaWall, to begin a line of experiments at once having in view the discovery of a substitute for the then high-priced chemical which would soon be impossible to obtain at any price.

The discovery of a substitute was of vital importance as during the past few years our people have realized more and more the necessity of home disinfection for the prevention of the spread of disease and as the State
