New York Provides For Its Boys During Winter

New York, Nov. 10.—Eight-tenths of a cent an hour is the amount which it costs New York to keep its boys off the streets and provide them with suitable recreation centers where they can play baseball, basketball and other games and have the added advantage of warmth and shelter during the winter months. As a result of these figures the city will be asked to appropriate \$125,000 for supplies to equip and carry on these recreation centers as the most efficient means of keeping the boys from acquiring bad habits after school hours.
