Jap Squadron Seeking German Cruiser Off South American Coast
Tokio, Dec. 11, 9:55 P. M. - According to reliable information reaching Tokyo to-day a squadron of Japanese warships is seeking the German converted cruiser Prinz Eitel Freiderich off the coast of Chile.

SAILS FOR GERMAN PORT
Washington, D. C., Dec. 11. - The first steamer to sail direct from New York for a German port since war was declared four months ago steamed out of the harbor to-day. The vessel is the El Monte, of the Southern Pacific Line, which came here from Galveston for coal. She is bound for Bremen, has aboard a full cargo of cotton and flies the American flag.

FRIENDS MAKE PROTEST
Washington, D. C., Dec. 11. - Protesting that the recognized honesty of Quakers or members of the Society of Friends, had been capitalized to sell cereals, whisky, stoves and other merchandise, members of the Friends' legislative board to-day asked committee of both houses of Congress to report favorably on legislation to prohibit the use in interstate commerce of the name of any religious denomination for trade purposes.

GERMANS ARE NEAR WARSAW
London, Dec. 11, 12:10 P. M. - The reported rout of the Austrian forces in Serbia, the borders of which country they crossed triumphantly just two weeks ago, together with the steady advance of the German center in the direction of Warsaw, on this, the third German invasion of Russian Poland, dominate the war news to-day. Poland, after occupying Lodz, near Pictrow, have been pushing to the northeast toward Warsaw along the railroad and one dispatch from Petrograd estimates that they are only fifteen miles from the Polish capital, while another message from Petrograd, speculating on the possible fall of Warsaw, warns the Russian people that the abandonment of this city, if such a move becomes necessary, should be regarded as a strategic operation on the part of the Germans rather than a decided German victory. It will be recalled that a similar view was expressed when the Russians retired from Lodz.

PARIS REPORTS PROGRESS
Paris, Dec. 11, 2:41 P. M. - The official statement given out in Paris this afternoon says the energy yesterday was active in the vicinity of Ypres. Three of his attacks were repulsed, but one of the important French trenches was reached by the forces of Emperor William. Nevertheless, French troops continue to make progress in the direction of the enemy's lines, according to the official report.

OFFENSIVE IS CONTINUED
Washington, D. C., Dec. 11. - Continuation of the offensive in West Galicia and successful repulse of Russian attacks southeast of Lodz, near Pictrow, were reported to-day to the Austro-Hungarian Embassy here from Vienna.

SITUATION IS REASSURING
Paris, Dec. 11, 5:40 a. m. - "The financial situation in France is reassuring," Alexandre Felix Ribot, the Minister of Finance, is quoted as saying in the Matin. "We have lived up to the present by an issue of treasury notes," M. Ribot continued, "of which \$2,000,000 francs (\$184,000,000) has been placed recently, and the total subscription for which exceeded a million francs (\$200,000,000). Thus there is no need at present to have recourse to a loan."

WONT SUPPORT CHILDREN
Charged with nonsupport of his five small children, last night, Herbert Drummond was held for court, bail following a hearing before Alderman Bayles. Mrs. Alice Anderson, of 1218 North Fourth street, preferred the charges, and testified that Drummond had not provided for his children for several months. Following the hearing of Mrs. Drummond, Mrs. Anderson, her sister, agreed to keep the children until provision could be made for them by the husband.
