

PRISONERS ARE WELL TAKEN CARE OF IN ENGLAND

Donnington Hall. Erected by Charles II, as Home For His Favorites Being Used

London, Jan. 18.—(Correspondence of the Associated Press) — Next to Donnington Hall, Holyport is the most important German officers' prison in England and for the first time the authorities have permitted unofficial neutrals to visit the camp.

Most of the prisoners have their quarters in the large buildings of the Holyport army reformatory school, but with an increase in their numbers it has been necessary to supplement this with temporary wooden structures built in the school yard.

The chief school building was erected by Charles II as a residence for his favorite Neil Gwynne. It has been restored for school purposes, and while architecturally ugly in appearance, forms a comfortable roomy building for its present use.

The temporary huts are built close about the main building and the whole group, which does not occupy more than three acres, is surrounded by a fence in the form of barbed wire entanglement. The commandant of the prison with his assistants are quartered in a large brick residence at the gateway of the school grounds which probably served as a lodge when the place was used as a country home.

RAILROAD FATALITIES LESS According to Late Reports Special to the Telegraph Chicago, Ill., Jan. 18.—According to the Bureau of Railway News and Statistics, one of the most remarkable safety records in the history of American railways was made in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1915, when the country's entire 256,000 miles of road operated with only 8,621 fatalities of all kinds, of which 5,984 were trespassers. The number is the smallest in thirteen years.
