TREASURY FUNDS SHOW BIG SLUMP

Working Fund Less Than it Has Been For Many Months at the Capitol

Pennsylvania's State Treasury contained \$2,571,622.06, including the sinking fund of \$661,110.02, at the close of January business, touching the lowest point known in over sixteen years or more.

During January the disbursements from the general fund also were greater than the totals of all receipts and in addition the State invested \$144,670.74 for the State fire insurance fund and \$11,330.57 for the permanent school fund.

The detail of the operations of the Treasury shows the following: Receipts—General fund, \$1,669,322.86; school fund, \$10,166.60; game fund, \$1,321.96; bounty fund, \$2,586.10; fire insurance fund, \$19,724.20. Total, \$2,210,081.72.

Payments—General fund, \$2,750,455.24; school fund, \$11,330.57; game fund, \$45,724.32; bounty fund, \$7,839; fire insurance fund, \$144,670.74. Total, \$2,959,918.17.

Balance—General fund, \$1,299,811.34, the lowest to which the working balance has ever fallen; sinking fund, \$661,110.02; school fund, \$15,148.28; game fund, \$245,145.40; bounty fund, \$2,586.10; fire insurance fund, \$47,412.86. Total, \$2,571,622.06.
