SELLING BECOMES MORE EFFECTIVE

Railroads Show Heaviness; Anglo-French Bonds Drop

New York, Feb. 24 - Selling became more effective later, liquidation by commission houses indicating the concern manifested in interior points.

The movement derived further impetus from the professional element with more vulnerable issues, as Oil, Motors, Sugars and Marine, Pfd. Marked heaviness was shown by New Haven, Canadian Pacific, St. Paul and Erie.

Additional cause for unsettlement was found in the continued heaviness of Anglo-French 5s, which fell to 94. Sales of this issue during the forenoon approximated \$1,250,000.

Bonds were heavy.
