PARADE FEATURE OF CITIES' LEAGUE

Johnstown Planning Great Time For Delegates to August Meeting

Johnstown, Pa., July 14.—A municipal parade will be one of the features of the convention of the League of Third Class Cities which meets here August 29, 30 and 31. This pageant was discussed at a meeting of the city

council and committees. The financial program of the convention will be drafted soon.

Harrisburg has already announced that 14 delegates will come from the Capital City and Allentown has sent word that two already have scheduled from that place.

The committee on the convention hall has selected the seventh floor of the Ft. Stanwix hotel for the convention sessions. Visiting delegates will heartily approve of this selection as the ballroom on this floor will be used for the general meeting, insuring an abundance of air and light.

The preliminary plans for the parade of the departments of the city government include all fire-fighting equipment. The surrounding boroughs will likewise be invited to send their equipment and apparatus.

Austrian Derby Unlike American Horse Races

Vienna, July 14.—(Correspondence of The Associated Press)—The great annual Austrian Derby, the banner race of the sporting season for all Austria-Hungary, this year proved even more than the anticipated success. It far outdid the Derby of 1915, in general interest, attendance and sporting features.

Many of the big figures in society and the smart and brilliant gowns of peace-time were lacking, but the threatening weather was largely to blame for that.

The Austrian race track crowd is totally unlike the one-time American crowd. The nerve-racked excitement of the American track is lacking, and when the horses come thundering

down the track—from right to left instead of from left to right and on sod instead of solid earth—there are seldom any shouts for this or that horse.

A feature of the Austrian track is the surprising number of women who bet on the races. Thousands of them crowded to the pari-mutuel booths on Derby day, feverishly thrusting their ten and twenty crown bills to the cashiers, and jostling making their way after each race to the pay-off booths. The women too furnished a sight that is not common on an American track, for countless numbers of them strolled about the paddock, or leaned against the rail smoking cigarette after cigarette. They stood about the huge announcing board with cigarettes between their lips, program in hand, carefully and skilfully checking off the numbers of the horses to run in the next race and the names of

the jockeys who were to ride them.

The only signs of war, if they would strike even the outsider, were the gray uniforms of officers and soldiers who mingled with the crowd.

The most popular favorite did not win, so there was a sorrowful element in the home-ward-bound crowd, but on the whole it was a happy and carefree throng, certainly one that gave no hint that fathers and brothers, husbands and sons are spread out along several hundreds miles of battle line, or wounded in the hospitals, or dead and buried.

HEAR YPRES GUNS IN LONDON

London, July 14.—The sound of the big guns at Ypres has been heard on rare occasions in various parts of London, occasionally at a point in Essex county 150 miles away and repeatedly at points in this country 125 miles from the scene of firing, according to

Miller Christy, a widely known member of the Royal Meteorological Society. The speaker said that windows in the Temple, a huge building of law offices almost in the heart of the city, were rattled violently many times by the Ypres guns. Lloyd George, minister of munitions, and Sir A. Canon Doyle, the speaker added, were among those who had heard the sounds.

PLAY MOUTH ORGANS IN FIGHT

London, July 14.—Two Scotch soldiers, who "at a critical moment steadied the men by getting up on the parapet of a trench and playing mouth organs while exposed to heavy fire," have been given the distinguished conduct medal. They are Company Quartermaster-Sergeant E. S. Beech and Lance Corporal Vickers, of the Seventh Battalion, Seaforth Highlanders.
