SEEK RELIEF FOR ARMENIANS

Churches Asked to Take Special Offering For War's Victims

Members of the executive committee of the Ministerial Association of Harrisburg and vicinity have issued a statement urging pastors and official boards of all churches in the city to take an offering for the relief of suffering people in Armenia and Syria, in response to a proclamation by President Wilson.

The President's proclamation is here repeated, together with the pertinent facts, the reading of which must move to deepest sympathy and concrete response.

Whereas, I have received from the Senate of the United States a resolution, passed July 7, 1916, reading as follows: "Whereas * * * etc."






