

BIG INCREASE IN UNITED OFFERING

Protestant Episcopal Women Gave Big Sum, Reports Rev. Bullitt



Substantial increases in the offering of the church from the diocese of Harrisburg. This diocese is among the divisions showing a pronounced increase. The united offering totals \$352,000 this year, of which the diocese of Harrisburg gave \$2,730. The increase in the total offering is counted by thousands. Harrisburg's increase is about \$500 over three years ago or about 5 cents per capita for the communicant members of the church in this diocese.

The diocese of Harrisburg, while one of the largest in area in the country is one of the smallest in church population. Mrs. James F. Bullitt, who is president of the auxiliary in this diocese, is in St. Louis with her husband, being a delegate to the auxiliary meeting.
