

SMOKE NUISANCE SHOULD BE WIPED OUT-DR. RAUNICK

Health Department Head Says Restricting Legislation Should Be Enacted

EDUCATION IS NEEDED Many Extensive Improvements Have Already Been Made by City's Industries

An educational campaign to eradicate the smoke nuisance in Harrisburg, followed by restricting city legislation, was urged to-day by City Health Officer J. M. J. Raunick.

Careful study of fuel consumption, installation of modern boiler and other heating apparatus, and modern appliances to eliminate much of the smoke, were some of the remedies suggested by the health officer.

Railroad officials declare that smoke inspectors, instructors for firemen, and educational motion pictures are producing the best results for them.



Educational motion pictures, showing how to fire engines properly to save fuel and cause the least smoke at the same time, are one of the big helps for the employees.

Men are employed to instruct all firemen how to fire under all conditions. In addition to the instructors there are smoke inspectors employed all along the line.


