

### "Grandmother of Russian Revolution" Given Warm Greeting After Release

Moscow April 5, via London.—Madame Catharine Breshkovskaya, "Grandmother of the Russian Revolution," has arrived here from Minusinsk, Siberia, after spending forty-four of her seventy-three years as a convict, prisoner and exile in the wastes of North Asia. Madame Breshkovskaya met with an enthusiastic welcome and was formally received by the committee of social organization. She replied in a speech in which she made a moving appeal for books and educational facilities to be extended to the masses of the people. Soldiers and members of the committee carried her into the street after the meeting.

### To Urge Increase in State Police Force

President Alva B. Johnson, of the Pennsylvania State Chamber of Commerce, has appointed a committee of the state chamber, consisting of D. E. Tracy, Harrisburg, chairman, Eugene C. Bonniwell, of Philadelphia, and Paul Littlefield, of Harrisburg, to represent the State Chamber in urging the House of Representatives to vote in favor of the passage of Senate bill No. 104, known as the State police bill, which

has been made a special order for third reading next Monday night at 9.30.

The state of war now existing between the emperie of Germany and the United States makes an increase in the force of the State police absolutely necessary to aid in maintaining order and properly guarding the railroads, bridges and other lines of communication within the state and to furnish police protection to factories engaged in the manufacture of war supplies for the government, the State Chamber says.

The State Chamber is co-operating with the Philadelphia Chamber of Commerce, the Chamber of Commerce of Pittsburgh and other business organizations in Pennsylvania to bring before the members of the House of Representatives the vital necessity of an increase in the police force of the State at this time. Judge Bonniwell and Mr. Tracy are directors in the State Chamber and Mr. Littlefield is secretary.

### TO ESTABLISH CONSULATE

London, April 5.—Germany will shortly establish a new consulate at Haharanda, on the Swedish coast of the Gulf of Bothnia, to deal principally with Russian business, according to a Stockholm dispatch to Reuter's. The dispatch says that the plan is ostensibly connected with negotiations regarding the release of civil prisoners in both countries, the numbers of whom aggregate more than 11,000.

CIVIL SERVICE TESTS The United States Civil Service Commission announces an examination for stenographer and typewriter to be held in this city on April 24 and will be open to both men and women. CARDINAL INDORSES WILSON Rome, April 5.—President Wilson's speech has been enthusiastically endorsed by Cardinal Gasquet, who represents the British Catholic church in Rome. Cardinal Gasquet says: "The speech is right in all its parts, in form as well as in substance. It is the best representative to the International Exposition of Christian morality, which is the foundation of international law."
