Charles of Austria Knows Value of Peace Berlin, April 16, via London, April 17.—Emperor Charles of Austria is quoted by Bjorn Bjornson, as saying in an interview at Luxembourg near Vienna: "I believe I know war better than most of the men who are at the head of the enemy powers to-day. I know not only the financial and economic effects of war, but I know also what it means to die in the trenches. I have seen men fall and die at my feet. Therefore I know also, maybe better than any other emperor or king, what peace means."
