Fire Does Small Damage

Saturday at 10:30 p. m. the homes' community, as well as the residents of Elizabethtown, were startled by repeated blasts of the whistle from the homes' power plant, which proved to be an alarm of fire in the fertilizer plant, situated east of and close to the power plant.

Stoner Wickenheiser, of the night shift, in going to work discovered the fire and gave the alarm. The night force immediately set to work procuring the homes' fire hose and attaching it to the fire engine pump in the power plant, and on the arrival of Engineer Arthur P. Hart, the pump was put in operation. Two lines of hose directly connected with the pump and one plug stream, with a pressure of 120 pounds, had the fire under control before the arrival of the Elizabethtown fire department.

This fire pump has been installed in the power plant for use in the homes' village. It is connected with the homes' water system and in case of fire in the village, steam can be switched on to it and in two minutes there will be a pressure of 120 pounds from all the plugs in the grounds.
