Wife Slayer Prefers Shooting to Gallows

Salt Lake City, Utah, July 5.—Howard De Weese, sentenced to death for the slaying of his wife last September, has chosen to be shot rather than hanged at the law's hands, July 6.

The laws of Utah provide that a person sentenced to death may choose to die by being shot. De Weese asked a prison guard questions relative to the caliber of the bullets, stating that he did not want the marksmen to "play" with him but to make death instantaneous.

De Weese eloped with the wife of Harry W. Fisher, husband of a woman from New York. They went to Reno and Pacific coast cities to live. Last September the pair who had married at Reno, were arrested at Salt Lake City.

Toulouse, France, July 5.—Cavalry horses have been dying in large numbers from a mysterious disease in different regions of the south of France. The mortality has reached sixty per cent. in some districts.

Some veterinarians assume that it is an infectious influenza; others suspect that a subtle means of slow poisoning is practiced on the animals while enroute from the farm to the cavalry depot.
