PRESENT COAL PRICES TO HOLD

While the coal dealers in this city have not yet received the official text of the recent order issued by Fuel Administrator Garfield, there is little likelihood of a change in prices here, according to dealers who were interviewed this morning. The dealers agreed that there can be no reduction on any grade except pea coal, which according to the recent order, has been reduced 60 cents a ton at the mines. It is probable that this reduction will be passed along to the consumer, but a great deal of the pea coal now in this city was purchased at the higher rate, and some of the dealers claim that even though the price on this grade is reduced, the reduction will be a small one. Pea coal is now quoted at \$7.25, based, it is claimed, upon the assumption that the greater part of the supply can be obtained from the railroad-owned mines. If it is impossible to procure a supply from the large operators, an increase of 75 cents a ton must be paid, in purchasing from small operators. One dealer is of the opinion that pea coal will be quoted at \$7, but does not believe the price will drop below that figure. Other dealers stated that they did not consider a change in price likely.
