FIRST PAYMENT OF LIBERTY BOND NETS \$685,000,000

Many Subscribers to Second Liberty Loan Bond Make Payment in Full

Washington, Nov. 15.—The first regular instalment payment on the Second Liberty Bonds, 18 per cent of the face value fell due to-day at the Treasury and Federal Reserve Banks. By to-night the government expects to add at least \$685,000,000 to its credit from the Second Liberty Loan and probably a great deal more, since many of the 9,400,000 subscribers paid in full for their bonds yesterday and to-day.
