Omega Lost Off Britain and Many Bodies Float Ashore

A British Post, Sept. 3.—The American steamship Omega has been torpedoed. The vessel foundered Friday night. Twenty-nine persons were saved and twenty-six are missing.

The Omega was 3,635 tons gross and was built at Belfast in 1916. She was owned by Barber & Co., of New York. The vessel was 400 feet long, 39 feet beam and 21 feet deep.
