

**Stop Exchange of "Gold Bricks" For American War Bonds**

Washington, Feb. 28.—Action to stop activities of persons or corporations seeking to exchange fraudulent securities or those of doubtful value of Liberty bonds and other government war certificates will be taken by the Federal Trade Commission. Announcement has been made

that Huston Thompson, a newly appointed member, would supervise the work.

Decision of the commission that it had power to act under the law prohibiting unfair methods of commerce in interstate trade was reached after it had considered urgent representations from the Treasury Department, the capital issue committee, and banking and commercial institutions over the country.

**Hays Wants Special Session of Congress as Soon as Possible**

New York, Feb. 28.—A special session of Congress, "as soon as possible" in order that the Republican majority in both houses may begin to function, was advocated by Will

H. Hays, chairman of the Republican National Committee, at a dinner in his honor here last night.

"The people elected the Republican congressmen and senators in the belief that they could aid by legislation in getting affairs in this country into economical, business, constitutional, sane, progressive operation," asserted Mr. Hays. "The people are entitled to have a special session as soon as possible that these men may be given an opportunity to function."

**No Arreets in Bond Theft at Oliver Office**

Pittsburgh, Feb. 28.—No arrest had been made up to a late hour last night in connection with the theft of \$100,000 worth of bonds from a safe in the office of the James B. Oliver estate in the Henry W. Oliver building here. City, county and private detectives are at work on the case. The robbery was discovered yesterday morning.

Officers, stationed in the building,

are at a loss to explain how the robber or robbers gained entrance to the office, for a strict pass rule is enforced throughout the night, and even well known tenants are forced to produce signed slips before they are admitted. The Oliver estate rooms are located on the twenty-second floor of the structure.

**Oppose Plebiscite in Alsace Lorraine**

Paris, Feb. 28.—The Superior Council of Alsace and Lorraine at its first meeting in the French war office adopted a resolution declaring

against the German proposals for a plebiscite in Alsace Lorraine. The resolution says:

"We refuse to stand for any foreign interference in our national affairs such as those attempted recently at Weimar and elsewhere with the object of making the future of Alsace and Lorraine depend on a plebiscite. We most energetically deny to all Germans the right of manifesting solicitude for us which comes forty-eight years too late. We are and will remain French without any plebiscite through the restoration of the rights violated in 1871."


