New York, March 21.—Wall Street.—The outstanding feature at the active opening of today's stock market was the extraordinary demand for steel shares and affiliated equipments following the adoption of the new schedule of prices by the manufacturer. U. S. Steel was especially stimulated, changing hands in numerous large individual lots at an overnight gain of two points. This advanced one to two points and more. Tobacco and distilling issues averaged one point gains. Shipping and coppers also improved moderately, but rails were higher. Local transactions were not further affected by latest receivership proceedings.

New York, March 21.—Dealing in U. S. Steel assumed almost record-breaking figures, aggregating about half of the first hour's business of 450,000 shares. Steel extended its gain to 2 1/2-3 points, carrying others of the same group substantially higher. Higher trading in shares were relatively steady. Interborough Rapid Transit and Interborough Metropolitan bonds developed increased weakness.
