

ROAD CONTRACTS FOR 64 MILES

Important Work in Cumberland and Lancaster Counties Authorized by Sadler

Highway Commissioner Lewis S. Sadler to-day announced award of contracts for sixty-four miles of State highway, the exact length of the seventeen contracts being 332,804 feet. Millions of dollars are in-

divisions which made such proud records in France. Major Frank C. Mahin, a member of Colonel Kemper's staff at 325 Market street, was an officer of the Fifth Division in all of the actions enumerated by General Pershing in his letter. The Major was gassed and wounded by shrapnel and ordered to this country for treatment.




