

Former Mayor of York Dies at Spokane, Wash.

York, July 17.—Milton B. Gibson, prominent manufacturer, lodge man, churchman and former mayor of York, died in a hospital on Tuesday at Spokane, Wash., the result of a carbuncle on the back of his neck.

He was in his sixtieth year. Mr. Gibson had attended a convention of the National Association of Piano Manufacturers at Chicago, and later to the National Rotary Clubs convention at Salt Lake City, from which place he went to Spokane, where he had gone to visit a cousin.
