The people of Arkansas and Texas are alive to the subject of railroads. In the former the route from Memphis to Little Rock, and thence to Fort Smith, is under consideration. A meeting has lately been held at Fort Smith, and another is to be held on the first Monday in December. The route is said to be an excellent one, so that the cost of constructing the road will be comparatively light. The people of Texas will continue the road from Fort Smith to El Paso. This is the track for the great railway to the Pacific. It will be made in a few years—long before the federal government will be able to accomplish anything of the sort. It is highly probable that a northern road to Puget's Sound will be under way and finished as soon as the southern one, if not sooner. The people of this country will not put up with only one road to the Pacific. It could not do half the business.

NATIONAL EDUCATIONAL CONVENTION.—This body assembled at Pittsburg on Tuesday, Bishop O'Connor, Gov. Simpson and a number of others, were elected members. Bishop Potter, the President of the Society, after a brief address, retired from the chair in accordance with previous notice, when Prof. Henry, of the Smithsonian Institute, was chosen as his successor.
