Opinions of the Supreme Court of the State of Tennessee, at Jackson, April Term, 1860.

THE STATE OF TENNESSEE vs. ROBERTS.
This is, to us, a case of a first impression. The facts, as alleged in the declaration, and proved, are as follows: Robert is a colored man, and certain accusations were placed in his hands, such as, against Westcott. Roberts received the execution on a negro slave, the slave was struck off to the slave, and he was sold for five hundred dollars. But, for the purchase, refusing to pay the amount of his bid, Robert was the last purchaser of the slave, and he was sold for five hundred dollars and five dollars less than the amount of the bid made by Robert and Adams.
