Governor William G. Brownlow has issued his proclamation of July 1st, assailing as seditious and rebellious the circular address of the Central Conservative Committee.

The Governor denounces said circular as intended to nullify the franchise law of the State by a false and rebellious construction for wicked and revolutionary purposes.

He assumes to declare that the Legislature intended by the franchise law, not by what is enacted in plain, unambiguous language, but by his own insubordinate knowledge, or from information derived from some source other than the law itself.

It is believed to be the first time in the history of the government where the Governor of any State has assumed to declare a circular addressed to the people as seditious, rebellious and revolutionary.
