WILSON SPEECH TURNING POINT

In Diplomacy of War—Tentative Peace Propaganda Killed Itself.

DUPLICITY REVEALED

President Balances All Americans to Support New Loan—What Enemy Will Lose.

Washington, April 10.—Just as the battle of the Marne was a turning point for the allies on the field of battle, so is the speech of President Wilson at Baltimore a great turning point in the diplomacy of the war.

From this time forward Mr. Wilson will not renounce moral force entirely, but he will lean heavily on the power of physical force to bring the people of Germany and Austria to understand that even a pacifically inclined nation like America can be goaded into the organization of all its people and all its resources for the grim business of war.

Only a few days ago the Kaiser was proclaiming that Germany was achieving victories by the sword and would get peace this way.

Wilson's Speech Long Foreseen. There has been no doubt of the president's position among Washington correspondents. They expected, at first, that he would expose the duplicity of the Von Hertling and Czernin peace speeches.

Casualty List of American Expeditionary Force Covering Period of Four Days.
