WHOLESALE MASSACRE OF DEPORTED GREEKS

Belief That Bulgars Plan to Wipe Out Entire Population of Captured Territory.

(International News Service.) Washington, June 12.--The wholesale massacre by the Bulgars of all but 140 of 20,000 Greeks deported from eastern Macedonia was reported to the Greek legation today by the bureau of prisoners at Geneva, Switzerland.

Officials here believe that it is the purpose of Bulgaria to wipe out the Greek populations of captured territory that a firm grip of northern Greece might be retained after peace is declared. Since the Greek deportations have taken place, it is pointed out that Macedonia is now inhabited largely by Bulgarians, who will establish future allegiance to their country rather than to Greece.

SHIP INSPECTORS RIGID Holland-American Liner Passengers Searched.

(Associated Press.) An Atlantic Port, June 12.--Before they are permitted to land the 612 passengers on board the Holland-American liner Nieuw Amsterdam, which arrived here yesterday, will have been subjected to the most thorough search of incoming travelers since America entered the war. British and American inspectors and the complement of customs men, health service physicians and intelligence officers, put on board the steamship numbered more than 150 individuals. On the steamer's arrival she was held for a three-hour inspection by health officials after which she was transferred to another anchorage, and the questioning of passengers continued throughout the night. Early today fifty members of the women's motor corps of America went on board the steamship to assist in inspection of women passengers.
