AMERICANS DOMINATE BATTLE FOR FIRST TIME

SECRETARY BAKER SEES BEGINNING OF BATTLE. After Thunder of Guns, Infantry Went Over Top Amid Silence. With the American Army in Lorraine, Thursday, Sept. 12.—The allied offensive on the western front for the first time dominated by American, the French co-operating, and in a military sense it is regarded as a continuing phase of the battle which began early last summer. Secretary Baker, with several other notable, witnessed the beginning of the battle from the vantage point of a French fort close behind the middle of the line. It was precisely 1 o'clock of a rainy, moonless night when a single flash of flame shot across the sky. It was followed by other flashes, which gradually merged into a sheet of white light on the horizon. Gradually there began to roll from this flame-lit area a mighty thunder, amidst which could be distinguished the rattle of machine guns, the boom of German return shells bursting. Bands of Vivid Light. The front over which the attack was made was so extended that the brilliant bands of vivid light soon stretched from far eastward to westward, lighting up the clouds. Soon there began to arise star shells, glistening rockets and flares thrown up by the enemy to betray the Americans should they leave their trenches suddenly to begin an infantry attack. To this general color scheme there was added a reddish glow from ammunition dumps exploded and buildings set on fire behind the enemy lines began to blaze, and an ammunition dump giving off this color exploded about 4 o'clock. German Shells Frequent. The character of the artillery fire changed slightly, lessened a little in intensity and German star shells burst with more frequency as 5 o'clock approached, as though the enemy suspected that was the hour set for the infantry attack. More and more ammunition dumps exploded just before the artillery bombardment suddenly resumed its original intensity, and as the sky was beginning to be tinged with dawn it again took on a white look along the horizon. Precisely at 5 o'clock the thunder of the guns accompanying the glare of light stopped and in the sudden silence the Americans went over the top. All along the line could be heard the chattering of German machine guns, and then suddenly the thunder commenced again when a barrage was laid down to protect the soldiers as they approached the German trenches.



EXEMPT BONDHOLDERS

Passage of Bill Affecting Buyers of Liberty Issues Expected. Washington, Sept. 12.—Immediate passage of the bill exempting large individual holdings of liberty bonds from surtaxes as a means of stabilizing the bond market was expected today in the house. The bill was reported favorably yesterday by the ways and means committee. Chairman Kitchin asked for prompt consideration in order to make the bill effective before the opening of the fourth liberty loan campaign Sept. 23. Senate leaders promised to put the measure through without delay. With this out of the way the house was prepared to take up amendments to the revenue bill, but because of the time given for consideration of the bond bill this probably may not begin before tomorrow.

ENEMY GENERALS ASK WHAT AILS ARMY?

Inquiries Reveal Much Wrong With Their Great War Machine. (By Joseph W. Grigg.) On the British Front.—(Copyright, N. Y. World.)—In a stirring special order to his troops on their memorable fight in the last month, Sir Douglas Haig shows it is his belief that whatever attacks may be contemplated by the enemy, they never again will be in the formidable proportions of the earlier onslaught. "We have passed through many dark days together. These will never return. The enemy has now spent his effort," are the words of the British commander-in-chief to the armies which captured 75,000 prisoners and 750 guns in the course of four weeks and wrested from the enemy nearly all his gains during the March offensive, and additional ground of great strategic significance. At no time in this war has more conclusive proof been obtained than lately that the whole German army is being put under the microscope by its military chief in an effort to find out why this one-time marvelous war machine does not work as it once did. And at no time have the German soldiers so conclusively shown that some of its most vital parts are missing—the most vital of all, morale. Hindenburg and Ludendorff are confronted with the perplexing problem of making brave and happy Germans who can withstand the allied teamwork, allied artillery and allied air forces. Haig's with Hindenburg's indictment of traitors within his own army, as well as at home. I have given in dispatches during the last month extracts from many German documents, confirmed by reliable prisoners, showing how the so-called "defensive fight for the fatherland" is an internal as well as an external job. In one of the latest orders to his troops, Gen. Otto von Below says there have been serious complaints against the rations, and he asserts that good cooking is the secret of making German rations satisfactory. In some of the divisions from which so much kicking has emanated, he points out, there have been units who have praised their rations—because they have good kitchen personnel. "Troops Must Be Kept Cheerful. "Disatisfaction with food always has an effect on the morale of the troops," Gen. Von Below adds, "and they must, especially in a war of position, be kept in good spirits by all possible means." Hint on grating was Hindenburg's only dietary prescription for the allies some months ago, but German prisoners' confessions indicate it is now included in their rations. But this searching for their weak parts is also divulging to the enemy high command that some of the most revered German war methods are themselves responsible for the weakening of the troops. Thus orders were recently issued that since the victorious British drive that no deep dugouts be made. Ostensibly it is because they have been destroyed during the previous drive, but it is also known that the marvelous German tunnels and rabbit warren defenses have played havoc with the morale of the troops, many of the Germans preferring to remain in the dugouts when ordered up to fight.

HUNS OPEN WAR ON AMERICAN DENTISTS
