of Georgia, United States Minister to Austria-Hungary.

Alexander R. Lawton, of Georgia, the newly-appointed Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary to Austria-Hungary, was appointed President to Russia two years ago by President Cleveland.

He was born in South Carolina in 1818. After his graduation at the West Point Military Academy he served eighteen months in the First artillery.

He became president of the Augusta and Savannah railroad. Five years afterward he was elected to the Assembly of his State, and in 1859 was elected to the First regiment of Georgia volunteers.

After the war he resumed practice at Savannah. He was elected to the State in 1871. In 1877 he was vice-president of the State Constitutional Convention.
