A Spy in the Camp.

J. R. RALEIGH'S BUDGET.

REWARDS OFFERED BY THE GOVERNOR FOR NEGRO MURDERERS. Buried by a Cave-In—Accidentally Shot—Railroad Matters—The Colored Fair.

RALEIGH, N. C., October 24.—Governor Fowle to-day offered rewards of \$200 each for the negro murderers—Jerry Mobane, for killing James Rogers in Durham county, and Abe McQueen, for killing W. W. Pierson in Montgomery county.

Two negro laborers at work in excavations for sewer-pipes here were buried this morning by the caving-in of earth. Thomas Burt had three ribs and a collar-bone broken and was otherwise injured. Henderson Scott was also buried, but he escaped unhurt. The caving-in was quite serious in this city. So far only one case has failed to prove fatal.
