Coming to the Front as a Fine Cattle County.

LARGE SHIPMENTS. The Cause of Missions—An Interesting Case to School-Teachers—The Thursday and the Fifteen Club—Personal Points.

BEDFORD CITY, VA., October 26.—(Special.)—Not only is Bedford a great place for apples, but is now coming to the front as a county for fine cattle. In a comparatively short space of time about 100 head of cattle have been shipped from the freight depot here. Most of them have been sent to Pennsylvania, during the past week G. R. Guizemann, of that State, has been in the county buying up cattle, and large numbers have been collected, driven in, and shipped.

There is something new in the way of exports, as hitherto the number of cattle sold from the county has been comparatively small. A new impetus has been given to agricultural interests, and a new era will now become a prominent feature in the industry.
