



THE LADIES' OFFICE.

(Showing the Statue of Jefferson.)


Turning west, you pass the ladies' office, the ladies' elevator, and the porte cochere, or carriage entrance to the building.

THE DINING-ROOM.

At the end of this hallway is the dining-room, which is, perhaps, the most elaborate room in the house. Its dimensions are 10x13 feet.

THE ARCHED DRIVEWAY.

Passing back through the rotunda and up through the porte cochere—the arched driveway on the Jefferson-street side of the building, about half way between Franklin and Main streets—the baggage-room is reached. This has connection

with the rest of the house through freight elevators. Continuing up a flight of stairs, through the hallway, one comes near the Franklin-street front to the stairway and elevators leading to the bedroom floors.

MANY CHAMBERS.

There are in all 32 bedrooms, thirty-four of which are set apart for employees. The walls of the guest chambers are decorated in either blue, green, pink, rose, or cream, with upholstered furniture, carpets, and curtains to match.

CONNECTING BATH-ROOMS.

Many of the rooms have connecting bath-rooms, with handsome porcelain bath-tubs. Toilets are on every floor, and at each end of the building. The

The Jefferson contains six bridal suites, two on each of the first three bedroom floors, looking out on the Franklin-street loggia. These suites, which consist of parlor, bedroom, bath, and toilet, are tastefully decorated with paper-mache effects.
